

FREE BUS TRAVEL for Marham Park Residents!

As a first resident/occupier of Marham Park you will be entitled to claim FREE TRAVEL on the new DRT Service.

Free DRT Travel

Receive credits for use on the Marham Park Flyer, to be used within 6 months of registering. This will be available for up to 4 members of your household.

How to apply

Apply for your free travel credit on the Marham Park Flyer to use within 6 months.

Simply email marhamparkflyer@mayerbrown.co.uk with

- A copy of a proof of address for each person (utility bill, driving licence, etc)

For existing residents you must apply by July 31st 2021. For those moving into their property after May 2021 applications must be within 3 months from when you moved into your new home as the first occupant

We will then issue each applicant with a code, which you will have 4 weeks to register on the service and access your free credits on the Marham Park Flyer App.

Fares (subject to annual review)

- Adult Ticket £2.50 single
- Child Ticket £1.75 single
- Concession Ticket £2.00 single
(see terms and conditions)

Free travel credits have no monetary value.

How to use the service

To use the Marham Park Flyer simply download the Marham Park Flyer app from the play store or app store. Book a journey by selecting your pick-up point and destination. After your free credit period you have the option to either pay using a card stored on your account or pay by contactless card on the bus.

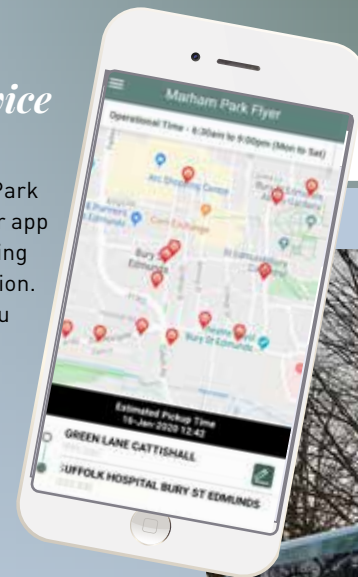
Once you book you will be instantly notified when the next available bus can pick you up from your location. In order to reduce your waiting-time the bus can also pick you up while others are on their journey if you are going in the same direction.

Journeys can be pre-booked up to one day beforehand.

Alternatively, you can book your journey on the Marham Park Flyer by calling the booking office 01638 60 80 80 between 8am – 4pm Monday to Friday.

You will also receive a full step by step user guide when you register to use the service.

The Marham Park Flyer

The new bus service for Marham Park residents is a demand responsive transport (DRT) bus service, commencing from 10th May 2021. Operated by The Voluntary Network, the Marham Park Flyer connects residents within and around Bury St Edmunds.

You'll be guaranteed a comfortable seat in one of our brand-new minibuses from 6.30am – 9pm Monday – Saturday.

BUS SERVICE AREA MAP

The Marham Park Flyer will operate within the highlighted area shown in the map below:



Q: What is Demand Responsive Transport (DRT)?

A: It's a flexible minibus service that can take multiple passengers all heading in the same direction. Using the app, simply register your details, select your pick-up and drop-off and we'll let you know when the bus is on the way to collect you.

You can use existing bus stops within Bury St Edmunds, simply search your pick-up and destination address and the app will show you the nearest bus stops.

Once your bus is on its way to you, you'll receive a text message and be shown the route to your collection point.

Q: What if I don't have a SmartPhone?

A: Please telephone 01638 60 80 80 to book your bus between 8am and 4pm, if you are travelling outside of these hours you can pre-book your bus.

COVID Measures

To ensure the bus is as safe as possible for travelling, the following measures have been put in place:

- All passengers must wear a face covering (unless they are exempt)
- The buses are restricted to a maximum of 4 passengers per bus – this will be adjusted in accordance with government advice
- Passengers are asked to use the provided hand sanitiser when boarding the bus
- Regular cleaning of the buses

If you have symptoms or you are isolating, please do not travel on the Marham Park Flyer.
